What is the investment per participant?

Clubs should budget \$250 per student, but we're expecting true cost to be less.

What will they learn from the programs?

Further development of leadership skills, personal qualities, problem solving strategies and creative thinking.

Will they be supervised?

Qualified personnel will be on hand at all times. There will be strict behavioral guidelines to which they must adhere.

What are the activities and programs?

Sunday June 12 afternoon check in. Exciting programs and projects aligned with Rotary International's RYLA objectives.

How do the participants get to Juniata College?

Participants are responsible for transportation to and from. If parents are unable to provide transportation, a local Rotarians may provide transportation.

When is registration deadline?

All reservations must be in by May 1st, 2005

How should participants be selected?

Guidelines suggest that candidates should display leadership ability, cooperative nature, awareness of current events, strong communication skills, good school performance, and enthusiasm for sharing skills. School guidance counselors are often either able to recommend or find a teacher to select the candidates. Clubs may develop their own criteria as long as they are high school juniors.
